

Directions for creating a  
**Student With Animal Picture**  
*using a Green Screen*

**REQUIRED ITEMS:**

- iPad with Green Screen by Do Ink
- Green screen background such as green fabric or green paper
- Tripod with iPad mount.
- Stylus (optional)

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. CHOOSING THE ANIMAL PICTURE:
  - a. On the iPad, the student will open **Pixabay.com** using Safari.
  - b. **Type in** name of animal in the search window. Click on Search.
  - c. Scroll through pictures and choose one you like. Think about how you would like to be placed into the picture.
  - d. **Click and hold down on the one you like** until a menu option comes up. Select **“Save Image”** to save to the Photo library.
2. TAKING THE PICTURE OF STUDENT:
  - a. Setup iPad on tripod in front of Green Screen.
  - b. **Open the Camera App.**
  - c. Adjust the iPad and tripod so that the picture fills the screen with green with no non-green edges showing.
  - d. Have the student guess where they want to be and/or pose. **Click the picture** to save it to the Photo library.
3. USING GREEN SCREEN BY DO INK:
  - a. Open Green Screen by Do Ink.
  - b. Click on the **+ sign** in the upper right corner and Create a New Project.
  - c. At the bottom of the screen, there are three empty lanes. Click on the **+ sign** to the right of the first lane.
  - d. From the **All** album, Choose the **Image** icon.
  - e. **Click** on the Image icon and **click** the student’s picture from the ‘**All**’ Album. Click **Use**.
  - f. In the second lane, click on the **+ sign** again and choose **Image**.
  - g. **Click on the Image of the animal** that the student previously chose.
  - h. Adjust the two pictures by switching between the two lanes. And sliding the pictures around. Also adjust the Sensitivity by clicking on the Color Wheel (“Chroma”)
4. SAVING PICTURE:
  - a. Click on **Image** instead of Video.
  - b. Click on **Save**
  - c. **Click on picture** once then on **Done** in the lower right corner.
  - d. Click on **Save to the Camera Roll**.
5. AIRDROP SEVERAL PICTURES TO ANOTHER LAPTOP FOR PRINTING:
  - a. Open picture in **Photos**
  - b. Click on **Select**.
  - c. **Check off** each picture for transfer.
  - d. Click on the **Share Icon** (a box with an arrow coming out of the top)
  - e. Click on the **laptop** to which you wish to send pictures.
  - f. On that laptop, click **Accept**.
  - g. The pictures will now be downloaded into your downloads folder for printing.
